Policy, People, & Practitioners

Monday, October 2nd

What: Digital Inclusion Week 2023 will begin Monday, October 2nd. To kick off this week of celebration, education, and connection, we will host a day-long series of panels that spark conversation at the intersections of research, policy, and community, relative to digital equity and empowerment. Through these conversational collisions, we hope to advance the application of lessons learned from digital equity and inclusion research and create pathways to action and policy implementation.

Community Engagement Events

Tuesday, October 3rd to Friday, October 6th

STEM Family Game Night: Throughout the week, Connect 313 will offer community-led Pop-up STEM Family Game Nights across the city of Detroit with local partners. These events will include interactive games and problem-solving activities that the whole family can participate in. Our instructors will focus on unplugged activities that don't require devices and help explain common features of computer science like "What is an algorithm?" and "How to debug code." This hands-on approach to learning will help develop the skills necessary to build new pathways to answering different types of problems with basic computer science concepts and problem-solving skills. Some classes will be offered on multiple days, in different locations, to help accommodate schedules throughout the week.

Small Business Technology Learning Circle: Throughout the week, Connect 313 will offer community-led Pop-up Learning circles that lead small business owners and entrepreneurs through information and discussion about getting started with technology. This program is for small business owners and entrepreneurs who want to engage in a peer learning experience around tech tools for business. Participants will watch a video and discuss how they interact or wish to interact with tech for their business. The hands-on activity for this group will be working through Detroit Means Business' Tech Assessment. At the end of the session participants can turn in their tech assessments and schedule one on one appointments with Detroit Means Business Tech workers to assist them in the areas that they indicate.

Community Trainings: Throughout the week we will be highlighting partner and community-led trainings, workshops, events, and talks, that are designed to bring digital equity resources into the hands of residents, right in their neighborhoods.
